BEELER, JOHN - "A REPORT ON LOCAL TRANSPORTATION"- ATLANTA, GA. - 1924

ARNOLD, BION J. - REPORT ON CHICAGO TRANSPORTATION PROBLEM - 1902

Mr. Arnold was the recognized authority on electric railways of all types at the turn of the Century. He made extensive surveys of service and operating problems of trolleys or subways in St. Louis, Baltimore, Philadelphia, Chicago and New York. This rare work, (hard to locate in libraries today) is in good condition with its 310 pp. of maps and drawings with a hard cover.
